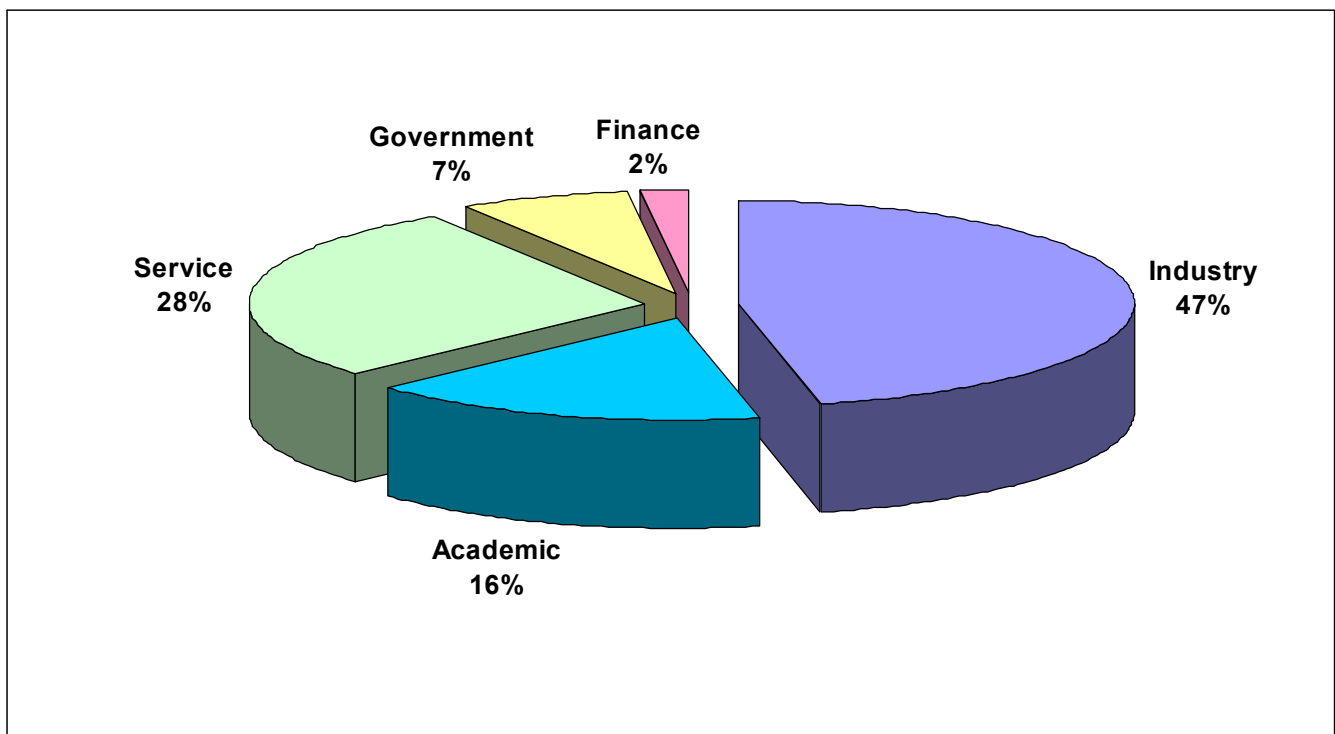

4. LOCATION OF EXHIBIT SPACE. iBIO Marketplace 2008 (the "Exhibition") will be held at the Hyatt Regency in Chicago, IL ("Exhibition Host Facility"). All measurements and exhibit space layouts shown on the floor plan are approximate. iBIO may make such modifications and changes to exhibit space assignments and to the location of the exhibit space as may be necessary to effect minor adjustments to the floor plan. In the event of any emergency or other circumstances beyond its reasonable control, iBIO may either substitute comparable exhibit space or to refund the total rent paid hereunder.

5. EXHIBITION MANAGEMENT. iBIO may establish such rules and regulations as it reasonably deems necessary for the general success of the Exhibition, and to decline, prohibit or expel any exhibit which it reasonably believes is in poor taste or is out of character with, or reflects poorly upon, the Exhibition or is in violation of the terms of this contract or any applicable law, rule or regulation.

6. INSTALLATION AND REMOVAL TIME. iBIO shall provide to Exhibitor prior to the Exhibition the specific requirements as to the time for installation and dismantling of exhibits. Such requirements shall be binding upon Exhibitor as though fully set forth herein. All displays must be in place and set up by the time of the official opening of the show. Exhibitors will be expected to be set up and tear down their exhibits according to iBIO's schedule of Events. In no event may any Exhibitor dismantle its booth prior to the close of the show.

7. EXHIBIT DATES. The Exhibit portion of iBIO's Marketplace 2008 will be held February 20, 2008 at the Hyatt Regency, Chicago, IL. iBIO may make minor changes to exhibit hours.

8. SUBMISSION DEADLINES. All items must be submitted on or before their stated deadline. Items submitted after their deadline may subject Exhibitor to additional fees. iBIO is unable to guarantee that it can or will deliver all benefits due Exhibitor hereunder related to items submitted after their deadline. Exhibitor is not entitled to any credit or refund of any kind for benefits not delivered to Exhibitor as a result of items submitted past their deadline.

9. CANCELLATION. In the event Exhibitor cancels all or part of the exhibit space contracted for hereunder, Exhibitor shall pay to iBIO a cancellation fee equal to all monies due as determined by the Payment Terms on the front of this contract. Any cancellation fee is due at the time of cancellation. All payments made to iBIO under this contract shall be deemed fully earned and non-refundable. The cancellation fees described herein are paid as liquidated damages and not a penalty. Exhibitor acknowledges that any cancellation will cause iBIO to sustain significant damages that cannot be precisely ascertained at contract time

10. USE OF EXHIBIT. Exhibitor shall provide adequate staff for maintenance and operation of its exhibit during all Exhibition hours. All demonstrations or other promotional activities, including the distribution of promotional material, shall be confined to the limits of the exhibit space. iBIO reserves the right to reasonably restrict, segregate, relocate or discontinue exhibits which are objectionable. In the event of any such restriction or removal, Exhibitor shall have no claim against iBIO based upon any such restriction or removal.

11. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. Exhibitor is solely responsible for the security of its own exhibit materials. Insurance on all exhibits is at Exhibitor's own expense. All property of Exhibitor is understood to remain in its sole care, custody and control in transit to or from and within the confines of the exhibit hall. iBIO shall have no liability for failure to perform its obligations hereunder where such failure to perform is due to any one of the following causes: destruction of or damage to the building or the exhibit area by fire or act of God; acts of a public enemy; strikes; the authority of the law; or any cause beyond its control. In the event the Exhibition is cancelled as a result of any of the aforementioned events, iBIO will reimburse Exhibitors for any unused rental fee paid.

12. INDEMNITY. Exhibitor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless iBIO, its affiliates, and any its officers directors, employees and agents from and against any and all losses, expenses, actions, claims and damages, including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or related to Exhibitor's installation, construction, removal or maintenance of its exhibit.

13. CARE. Neither Exhibitor nor its representatives or agents shall injure or deface the walls or floors of the Exhibition Host Facility, the exhibit spaces, or the equipment in the exhibit spaces. All materials used by Exhibitor shall comply in all respects with all applicable laws, rules and regulations regarding fire safety and electrical equipment. Exhibitor shall also comply with all reasonable requests of officials of the Exhibition Host Facility and iBIO with respect to the installation, conduct and disassembly of its exhibit

14. MISCELLANEOUS. Except as otherwise set forth herein, this contract contains the entire understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof. This contract cannot be assigned, transferred or sold by either party. The rights of either party under this contract shall not be deemed waived except as specifically stated in writing signed by an authorized representative each party. This contract and the rights of the parties hereunder shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois without regard to Illinois' choice of law rules. Any action brought to enforce the terms of this contract may be brought only in a court having a situs within the State of Illinois and the parties hereby expressly consent to personal jurisdiction in any such court.
